

Copyright Reminder 2016

A reminder to all members that you must gain permission for use of text that has previously been published in print on the internet.

Many members of Girlguiding write documents to ensure that quality information is available to either a particular group of guiding or the membership at large. Works are protected by copyright without a need for formal registration. However, if there is no statement of copyright on a document, it can often be unclear who owns the rights to it. In these cases genuine errors can happen - such as linking to documents without considering that there might be a copyright issue.

If you have created a document or published text in print or online we would advise you to add a copyright statement (eg © Jane Doe 2016); this may seem a very formal but it will help to protect against any errors of information sharing.
