Frequently asked questions:

When is the takeover event happening?

The event is being held from **Friday 11 to Sunday 13 September 2026**. Tickets can only be purchased for the full event.

What section is this event suitable for?

This weekend event is exclusively for Brownies.

What will the event involve?

A jam packed weekend of unmissable adventures, activities and crafts alongside other guiding members from all across Anglia region. This event is exclusive to Girlguiding members.

Where are the locations?

How much are the tickets?

♦ Brownie ticket – £145

Includes: 2 nights of accommodation, all activities, catering*, event badge and exclusive Cosmic branded bucket hat.

◆ Leader ticket (includes young leaders) – free place for every 6 Brownies booked. Additional leaders charged at £100.

Includes: 2 nights of accommodation, catering* and event badge. Activities are not inclusive.

*Catering is included from breakfast on Saturday 12 September through to lunch on Sunday 13 September. An optional dinner is also available on Friday 11 September at an additional cost of £6 per person. Please add on at the time of booking.

Will there be discounted carer tickets?

Unfortunately the venues do not offer discounted carer tickets so these will not be available.

Can parents or non-guiding members attend for safeguarding ratio purposes?

This is an exclusive Girlguiding takeover event, there will be no other members of the public invited to attend across all 4 centres.

When can we book?

Tickets are on sale now! A <u>non-refundable deposit</u> will be required upon booking. Deposits are £50 per Brownie and £30 per leader.

Alternatively, contact **events@girlguiding-anglia.org.uk** to make a booking if you are unable to make payment online. Manual bookings will require a deposit payment to be supplied within 14 days to secure places.

What are the timings of the weekend?

You can arrive from 4pm on Friday 11 September. Programme will begin that evening with entertainment starting at 7.30pm. All girls will be scheduled to take part in 5 adventurous PGL activities, 1 craft session and 1 free time session. Sessions will last 75 minutes each.

On Sunday, departure is planned following the final session at 3.15pm. However, if travel arrangements are required earlier, we can schedule your free time session at the end of the event, allowing for departure from 12.30pm once you have collected your packed lunches.

What's included in my ticket price?

Tickets include accommodation, catering, all activity sessions, craft session and evening entertainment. Everyone will also receive an event badge and girls will receive a branded Cosmic bucket hat.

Bedding is provided for all adults, girls will be required to bring a pillow and sleeping bag.

Do I need a license or qualification to attend this event as a leader?

A Going Away With license will be required for this event. However, if you are attending with another unit who have a license holder, please let us know and we will ensure you are sharing accommodation.

Is there a Facebook group?

Is this a uniformed event?

Uniform is not required during this event, but traditionally girls are asked to wear uniform on arrival and departure.

Will there be template risk assessments/consent form available?
