

Peer education FAQs

What is required for me as a leader?

- Prior to the session you will need to hold a pre session conversation so they can understand your unit best before the session.
- You will also need to share letters provided by your peer educator with your parents after the session.
- As a leader you will still be in charge of the session, should there be any disclosures during this session you must act upon this appropriately.
- After the session you may need to complete further tasks to earn the session badge, your peer educator will advise what is needed.

Will there be a cost to our unit?

The peer educators can claim expenses back on a session which covers their travel and any recourses. They may request for some resources to be provided by the unit; this will likely be the usual things you need for most meetings.
