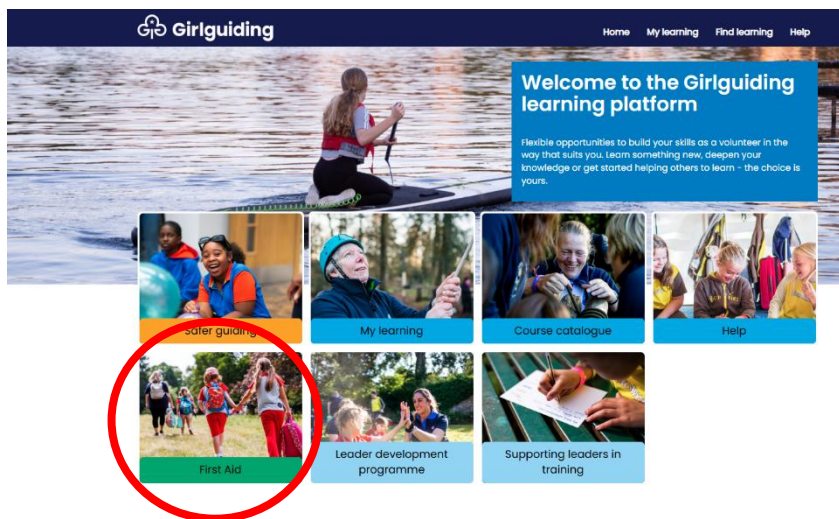


Quick guide to uploading an external first aid qualification

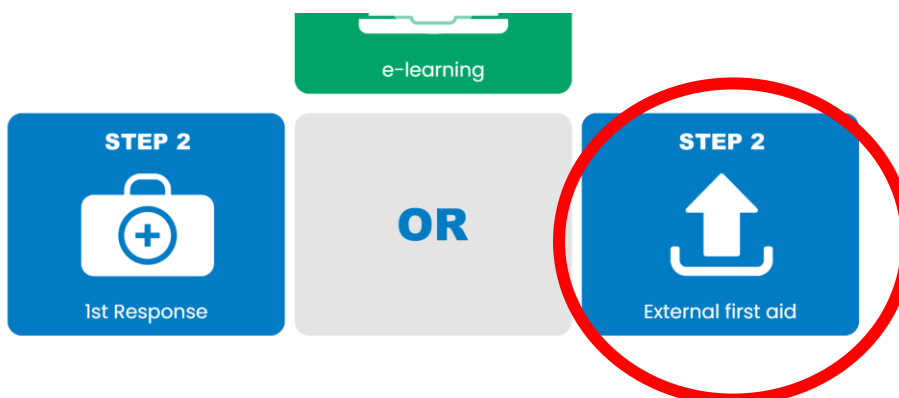
When uploading an external 1st response, please ensure you allow a minimum of 21 days for it to be signed off. This is to allow time for the region verifiers to review your upload and share any feedback which may require action from you.

Step 1 – Log on to the learning platform. The link is at the top of the Girlguiding website and the log in the same as for your GO account.

Step 2 – Click on the first aid box



Step 3 – Click on step 2 – external first aid. (Ensure you've already completed the e-learning, or it will prompt you before you can upload your evidence)



Step 4 – Select either 1 or 3 year, depending on how long your course is valid for.



Step 5- Download the external first aid course form. Complete it and save it as a document ready to upload.

Welcome

If you have already completed a first aid course outside Girlguiding, you can upload your evidence of completion.

What kind of evidence?

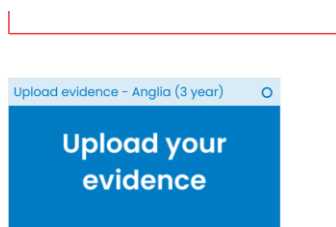
First, you need to complete and attach a copy of the [external first aid information form](#) (automatic download).

In addition to this, you will need to provide acceptable evidence which is usually a certificate, but other items (e.g. record) may also be used.

You can submit an image, a PDF or other formats (**max size: 5MB, max attachments: 3**).

Please ensure that the date of your qualification / attendance / completion is clearly shown.

Step 6 – Click on ‘upload your evidence’



Step 7- Follow the on-screen instructions to upload your evidence.

How do I upload and submit my evidence?

1. Select **Add submission**.
2. Select **Add file** in the left hand corner, then **Upload a file**, then **Choose file** and select your file.
3. Enter a name for the document, then select **Upload this file**.
4. Follow the steps above to add your completed external first aid information form.
5. Check you have uploaded the correct documents.
6. Select **Save changes**.

The submission status should now be:

Note: You can only upload 3 documents, so is advised to include multiple pieces of information within 1 document. If you have difficulties, please contact the region office by emailing: learning@girlguiding-anglia.org.uk.

Step 8 – Scroll down the page to the “Add submission” box at foot of page:

Step 9- Upload your certificate, completed form, syllabus and any supporting evidence from your trainer.


You will be sent to a first aid verifier to review. You'll receive an email to confirm once your uploaded certificate has been approved.

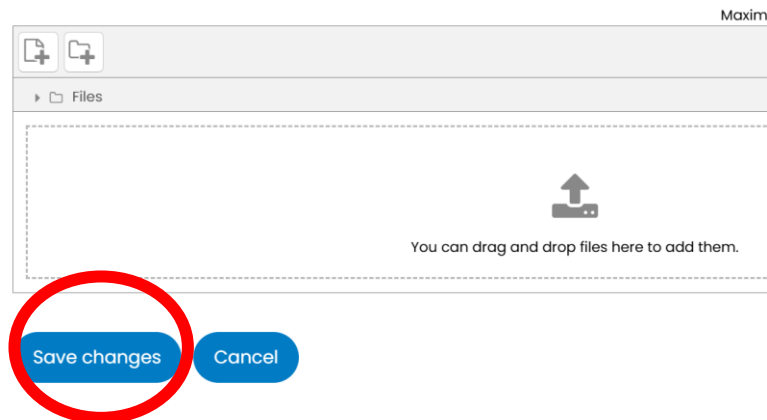

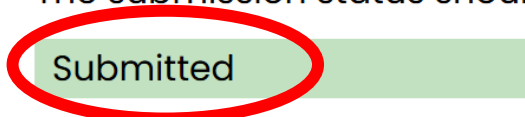

Step 11- Click on choose file to search for the files on your computer. Select those required, as detailed at step 9.

Step 12- Click on “save changes” and you should see ‘Submitted’.

Step 13:

If the verifier leaves any feedback, you will receive a notification via email (please do check you junk/spam folders). Log back into the learning platform where you will be able to see the feedback left.

Once the verifier is satisfied that the training you have completed meets the Girlguiding requirements they will mark your upload as sufficient. This will sync to your GO record as long as the e-learning has been completed.
