

A Safe Space

Safe Space expires after 3 years. If you still hold a role that requires a particular level of training, you'll be reminded to renew it 3 months before it expires. Not all leaders who complete level 3 have a role that makes this level compulsory, so you may not get reminders and it'd be a good idea to plan ahead by checking your 'valid to' date in the 'my achievements' area of GO.



You'll need to attend a local training session for 1st response and complete the 1st response e-learning every 3 years to keep your knowledge up to date.

It'll train you to provide first aid to members in emergencies - in or outside of your unit meeting place. The course was created specifically for members of Girlguiding and The Scout Association.
