What are Cookies?

Cookies are small amounts of information which some websites store on your computer to make it easier for you to log on to and use them during future visits. In reality, a cookie is a small text file which is stored by the user's browser and contains data, not code, so it can't contain a virus or spyware. This doesn't mean that all cookies are harmless in intent, but they can only ever store information.

_gat	1 minutes	Used to throttle requests by Google Analytics
_gcl_au	3 months	Used by Google AdSense for experimenting with advertisement efficiency across websites using their services.
_gid	24 hours	Used to distinguish users by Google Tag Manager
cookieconsent_status	365 days	Used by the website to distinguish if a user has consented to the Privacy Policy: https://www.girlguiding-anglia.org.uk/privacy-policy . This also refers to a cookie policy on a cookie page which is not clear on its location.
giles_session	2 hours	Custom website session identifier for users.
intercom-id-ov1kjsv	9 months	Anonymous visitor identifier cookie for use with Intercom chat plugin.
wp-settings-time-{user_id}	1 year	WordPress sets a few wp-settings-{time}-[UID] cookies. The number on the end is your individual user ID from the user's database table. This is used to customize your view of admin interface, and possibly also the main site interface.

How we use your information

Girlguiding Anglia uses 'analytical' cookies on this site to allow us to monitor website traffic and analyse how visitors use it via Google Analytics. This service tracks information about how visitors interact with the site, including the number of visitors to our website, where visitors have come to the website from and the pages they visit. We use this information to help us improve our website.

Such information will not identify you personally it is statistical data about our visitors and their use of our website. This statistical data is completely anonymous and does not identify any personal details whatsoever.
